Env. Engineer (HQ) For Sr. Env. Engineer-II (HQ) Minutes of 8th meeting of State Level Committee Constituted in compliance of Hon'ble NGT orders dated 16.1.2019 in OA No. 606 of 2018 held under the chairmanship of Justice Pritam Pal, former Judge, Punjab and Haryana High Court, now as Chairman of the Monitoring Committee in conference room directorate of Urban Local Bodies, sector-4, Panchkula on 29.10.2019 at 11:00 AM to review the status and progress w.r.t management of solid waste.

The list of the participants is as per **Annexure-1**.

At the outset, Member Secretary, HSPCB, cum MS of SLC welcomed the Chairperson and members of the Committee and thereafter agenda of the meeting was taken up for discussion.

Agenda Item 1 : Confirmation of Minutes of previous meeting

The Minutes of the 7^{th} SLC meeting were circulated and these are confirmed by the members of the Committee.

Agenda Item 2 : Review of actions taken on the decisions of previous meetings

Chairman expressed his experience on the visit of the Monitoring Committee to Rohtak city w.r.t management of solid waste and appreciated the works undertaken by the State.

Development & Panchayat Department, in response to the decision taken in the 7th SLC meeting submitted as under

- Tenders in all the 22 Districts covering all the model panchayats as notified, are being floated and the work of SWM has been allotted in 7 districts namely Ambala, Bhiwani, Fatehabad, Gurugram, Mahendergarh, Mewat and Yamunanagar.
- In 2 districts namely Faridabad and Kurukshetra, the work is being done through Gram Panchayats.
- District Sonipat is in the process of signing MoU with Sustainability Vision Foundation Trust for SWM on no-profit no-loss basis.
- The tenders have not been finalized in the remaining 12 districts so far.

The Committee directed that the matter be expedited and a time bound action plan be submitted to HSPCB for follow up.

Agenda Item 3 : Status of compliance of Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016

The Committee reviewed the status of compliances made in seven Model towns vis-a-vis the timelines prescribed by Hon'ble NGT. ULBD apprised that the compliance is under progress and the timelines will be met as per NGT directions. It was observed that in Panchkula, processing by Bulk Waste Generators (BWG) is done only in 23 units out of 86 identified.

Chairman informed that he would visit Panchkula before the next meeting to check the progress made on ground in comparison to the data presented.

The progress in rest of the model towns and Panchayats was noted. Similarly, the progress in case of other towns were explained by ULBD and Panchayat Department and it was assured that the timelines given in the plan, shall be met with.

Agenda Item 4 : Status of compliance of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016

Member Secretary, HSPCB apprised as under:

- The Action Plan for Plastic Waste Management shall be updated and notified at the earliest.
- In Sonepat, Karnal and Panipat 4,000 Challan on single use plastic have been issued.
- 85,000 cloth bags have been distributed by HSPCB, during the previous month, as an alternative to plastic carry bags.
- ULBD informed that it distributed around 1,38,000 cloth bags under CSR initiatives for spreading awareness to reduce the use of plastic bags. "Jhola banks" has been introduced to reduce the use of plastic bags, it was further informed.

Principal Secretary, Rural and Panchayat Department apprised as under:

- A special drive is being organized in each district every month for collection of segregated plastic waste and creating awareness about the possibilities for its recycling and re-use.
- Chairman suggested that small towns and cities may also be targeted and the same practice of distribution of bags in these small towns may be initiated and possible alternatives to substitute the use of Plastic bags be studied.

- It was suggested that a policy decision may be taken to facilitate the use of plastic waste in road construction and other activities.
- Smt Urvashi Gulati, IAS (Retd), Member of the Committee advised that ULBD and Panchayat Departments should select certain model cities / Gram Panchayats, and declare them 'Plastic Free' and special efforts be initiated in those selected places to ensure 100 % plastic free. This will encourage other cities to follow and can be projected as a success model to others.

Agenda Item 5 : Status of compliance of Construction & Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016

It was apprised as under:

- For management of Construction and Demolition waste, ULBD was advised to devise the draft policy before November 2019.
- The Committee was apprised on the status of progress made in the C & D Management projects and ULBD informed that the process has already been initiated and tenders are likely to be received by Dec 2019.

Agenda Item 6 : Status of compliance of Bio Medical Waste Management Rules 2016.

It was apprised as under:

- Regarding compliance to be made under the Bio- Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 in the State, MS, HSPCB informed that PGIMER has been engaged for conducting the Gap Analysis study, whose report is awaited.
- About 90% of HCFs in the State have already been covered under authorization and the rest is under process.
- With regard to the compliance of Hazardous Waste Management in the State, HSPCB informed that it is proposing to allot a profile study for assessing the quantum and quality of hazardous waste being generated by a specific type/category of industry.

Agenda Item 7 : Review of Progress / compliance status in OA No.514/2018 (Vivek Kamboj Vs UoI and Others).

The committee was informed that in compliance to NGT orders in OA. 514/2018 a Committee has been constituted by the State Government vide its order dated 22.07.2019. ULBD has submitted an Action Plan before

Hon'ble NGT and an ESCROW account has also been opened by the State, as directed by NGT.

ULBD informed that MC Gurugram has issued work order for rental machinery and resources to process 600 TPD legacy waste on 07.10.2019. It is expected that the processing of legacy waste will be started by mid of November 2019. The Committee was further informed by ULBD that the Action plan, as directed by NGT, is still under preparation and will be submitted at the earliest.

The progress was noted, and it was directed that strict compliance of the NGT directions must be ensured in a time bound manner. Chairperson informed that the committee will visit Gurugram during the month of November, 2019 to review the progress.

Agenda Item 8 : Review of Progress of compliance in OA No. 1011/ 2018 in the matter of Jagdish Kumar Vs State of Haryana.

In compliance of directions of NGT in OA No. 1011/2018, ULBD informed as under:

- The tenders for Rohtak Cluster Waste to Energy Project was invited on 05.03.2019 but no bids were received. After finalization of tenders any further commitment can be made on commissioning date of the Waste to Energy Plant.
- The compliance of Hon'ble NGT directions is being done by MC, Gohana and has taken various steps for compliance of the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- 100% Door to Door collection is being done in all the wards of Municipal Council, Gohana and out of 23 wards, 50% segregation of waste is being carried out in 12 wards.
- ✓ Efforts are being made to make the dumpsite odour free and tenders regarding sanitation park/compost pit at the dumpsite area for treating fresh wet waste has been invited by MC Gohana which is under process.
 - ✓ However, MC Gohana has constructed 03 compost pits on their own level before the finalization of Sanitation Park /compost pit tender.
- ✓ The waste on the plot belongs to petitioner has been cleared by the Municipal Council, Gohana. A tender has been called for treating the legacy waste lying on the dumpsite measuring 4.7 acre and is under process of evaluation.

✓ MS, HSPCB requested ULBD to revise the plan as directed by NGT and send the same to HSPCB for incorporating the same along with the progress, with the quarterly report of 0.A 606/2018

Agenda Item 9 : Review of Progress of compliance in OA No. 540/2019 in the matter of Resident Welfare Association Vs State of Haryana

In compliance to Hon'ble NGT order in OA. 540/2019, it was apprised by ULBD that report of 40 ULBs has been compiled and for remaining ULBs the same will be collected and compiled in 2 weeks' time.

The Committee advised ULBD to submit the report of 40 ULBs (for which the status has been compiled) to HSPCB and to ensure forwarding the rest by due time.

The Committee decided that, henceforth, Senior Officer of selected two Municipal Corporations may be called in the meeting. Accordingly, it was decided that Commissioner of Gurgaon MC and Executive Officer, Rewari be called for 9th SLC meeting. The Committee will also visit Gurugram and Rewari to review the progress of their works.

Chairperson desired that the field visit to Panchkula may be organized to check the compliance at ground level and the date may be finalized by ULBD after consulting MC, Panchkula and Chairman. The Committee also advised that all the waste management strategies be coordinated with the NGOs, CSOs, RWAs and SHGs to ensure participation of general public and thereby the success.

Meeting ended with a vote of thanks to all the participants.
