**Proceeding/Minutes of Public Hearing for mining of Quartzite & Masonry Stone from the Golwa mine with 5.4 MTPA production capacity over an area of 24.40 Hectare located in Village Golwa, Tehsil Nangal Chaudhary, Distt. Mahendragarh, State Haryana by Sh. Ashok Kumar S/o Shri Ram Avtar, production capacity (5.4 MTPA), ML Area 24.40 Ha. held on 03.03.2023, 11.00 AM at site.**

M/s Ashok Kumar S/o Sh. Ramavtar was originally granted mining lease area 154.48 Ha. in village Golwa, District Mahendragarh but at the time of handing over the possession by demarcation of kharas it was found only 111.0 ha. area but same could not be implemented due to some area was falling in Aravali plantation restriction and further evaluated for 24.40 Ha. area sanctioned by Competent Authority i.e. Director Mines & Geology Department, Haryana vide letter No. Glg/Hy/E-2637/5473 dated 31.10.2018.

The above mentioned proposed mining project pertains to opencast stone mining along with associated minerals on the total land measuring 24.40 Hectare at Village Golwa, Tehsil Nangal Chaudhary, Distt. Mahendragarh. As per EIA Notification of Ministry of Environment & Forest, Govt. of India, New Delhi dated 14.09.2006 & subsequently amended on 15.01.2016 for extraction of Minor Mineral and associated minerals require Environment clearance from SEAC/SEIAA before the commencement of any ground activity. The proposal for the ToR was granted by SEIAA, Haryana vide letter No. SEIAA(143)/HR/2022/1212 dated 29.07.2022. The proponent submitted the request to HSPCB for conducting public hearing process at site.

In this regard an advertisement for conducting Public Hearing was published in local News paper in Dainik Jagran, in Hindi and also In National Newspaper in English on dated 13.01.2023. Sh. Krishan Kumar, Regional Officer, Mahendragarh, Haryana State Pollution Control Board sought the permission from Deputy Commissioner for starting the public hearing and informed the Public about EIA notification, 2006 provisions also explained that it is compulsory for projects to go through Public Hearing to general public present at site in the chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner, Mahendragarh.

Dr. Jai Krishan Abhir, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Mahendragarh welcomed all stakeholders to the Public Hearing of Golwa Stone Mine, and informed the public to bring forward their suggestions, objections and comments etc regarding the said project.

The Regional Officer, Mahendragarh, Haryana State Pollution Control Board asked the consultant from M/s Vardan Enviro Net to present to Public about the features of mine.

The representative of M/s VARDAN ENVIRONET, Sector-5, IMT, Manesar, District Gurugram Mr. Adarsh Bhardwaj, consultant then explained the Public about the above said mine through and powerpoint presentation regarding brief summary of whole mining project covering main features of the project and also cost of project, environment management plan, employment generated, mining plan, green belt, water requirement, ecology and biodiversity, CSR fund. After summary explain by consultant, the Regional Officer, Mahendragarh asked the participants from public to come forward and submit their views, comments, suggestions and objections if any for the proposed mining project at Village Golwa, Distt. Mahendragarh, Haryana.



- 2 The project proponent will take proper measures to address all the issues raised in public hearing.
