People of the concerned villages of District Ambala were informed through Public notice in Newspapers published on 29.11.2024 and Public announcements to attend this hearing through Sarpanch of Villages concerned.

Sh. Parth Gupta IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Ambala (henceforth Chairperson) presided over this public hearing. The attendance sheets of officers from various departments and the residents of nearby villages present in public hearing is given at **Annexure-'A'.** 

Besides Govt. Officers/ officials of the District Administration, residents from the nearby villages attended the hearing at site of the proposed project. The complete Videography and Photographs of the public hearing are enclosed separately (in Pen Drive) at **Annexure-'B'**.

Sh. Ajay Singh, RO, HSPCB, Ambala Region, welcomed the Chairperson along with other Officers came from various departments and general public present in the hearing. The Regional Officer, HSPCB outlined the project brief & the purpose of the hearing as per the requirement under the provisions of EIA Notification dated 14th September 2006, or as amended to date. He particularly emphasized that those present in the hearing can raise their queries/ suggestions/objections regarding any concern after completion of detailed presentation to be given by environmental consultant on behalf of project proponent/ contractor.

Further, formal permission to start the process of public hearing was granted by the Chairperson and asked the Project proponent to give the presentation of the project in detail and remedies taken by the project proponent to control the environmental impacts which may arise after establishment and commissioning of the project.

The environmental consultant Sh. Deepak Kumar of M/s P and M Solution, Noida of Project Proponent welcomed the participants and started the presentation. He explained about the project regarding project location, description of the project and same is as under:

APPLAT

- The mining lease is sanctioned in favour of M/s P S Enterprises. The proposed project "Rayawali Sadhanpur Sand mining Block" for sand mining in total area of 90.29 Acres /36.55 Hectares in villages Rayawali, Sadhanpur, Jatwar, Samru, Khera Jatan ,Bodoyo & Tepla, Distt- Ambala.
- The Letter of Intent (LOI) was issued by Mines & Geology Department, Haryana, Chandigarh vides Memo No- DMG/HY/Cont./Rayawali-Sadhanpur Block/AMB./2023/4188, Dated 21-07-2023 for Lease Period of 8 Years.
- NOC obtained from Irrigation department, Haryana vide their letter no.4283-87/6-W (NOC) dated 07.11.2024.
- Further Consultant informed that an application was filed by M/s P S Enterprises at MoEF & CC, New Delhi for getting Environmental Clearance under EIA Notification 14.09.2006 for proposed capacity of 13,79,000 TPA(ROM) in an area of 90.29 Acre i.e 36.55 Ha. in respect of "Rayawali Sadhanpur Sand mining Block" for sand mining in villages Rayawali,Sadhanpur,Jatwar,Samru,Khera Jatan ,Bodoyo & Tepla, Distt- Ambala.
- The project proposal was submitted to State Level Expert Appraisal Committee-(SEAC), Haryana for its appraisal. After considering the application of the project, an auto TOR "Terms of Reference" generated/issued by SEAC, Haryana. vide letter no. SEIAA/HR/2024/219 dated: 28.10.2024 to the project for the preparation of draft EIA Study Report. Thereafter the project proponent has submitted draft EIA report to the HSPCB along with required fee with request for conducting the public hearing for the project as per the procedure prescribed in the EIA Notification dated 14.09.2006.

After the completion of presentation RO, HSPCB, Ambala, requested the public to raise their suggestions, objections, views, queries and doubts related to the project. Sh. Parth Gupta, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Ambala, Chairperson also encouraged the public to come out with their suggestions/ queries/ doubts, if any, pertaining to the proposed project so that the same may be cleared by the PP on the spot.


After Receiving the suggestions/ queries from the local public and addressing the issues raised during the public hearing the Public Hearing was ended with the permission of the Chairperson.
