Proceedings of the Public Hearing

Proceedings of the Public Hearing for Project requiring clearance under Environmental Impact Assessment Notification, 14th September, 2006 (as amended) for Integrated Solid Waste Management project at Malpura and Rajpura village, Tehsil Dharuhera, District Rewari, Haryana by Municipal Committee, Dharuhera on 20/08/2025 at 11:00 AM.

The proposed project Integrated Solid Waste Management project at Malpura and Rajpura village, Tehsil Dharuhera, District Rewari, Haryana by Municipal Committee, Dharuhera is required to obtain the Environmental Clearance as this project is covered under amended EIA Notification dated 14th September, 2006 of the Ministry of Environment and Forest, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The project proponents have applied for the Environmental Clearance to SEAC Haryana, Government of India and requested to conduct a public hearing. In this regard, an advertisement regarding public hearing notice for publication in leading Hindi (Dainik Jagran) and English Newspaper (Indian Express) was published by Haryana State Pollution Control Board on 10th July 2025. The public hearing was conducted by Haryana State Pollution Control Board on dated 20/08/2025 under the chairmanship of **Sh. Suresh Kumar SDM, Rewari**, Haryana and alongwith other officers from respective departments. The attendance sheets of the officers and general public who attended the above said hearing are enclosed as Annexure-A & B. The CDs of videography of the entire public hearing are enclosed as Annexure-C.

Sh. Nipun Gupta, Regional Officer, Haryana State pollution Control Board, Rewari welcomed the SDM, Rewari with all other officers & general public present during the hearing and thereafter sought permission from the SDM to start the Public Hearing. He briefed about the EIA notification dated 14.09.2006 and process of Public Hearing. He also requested the public to speak one by one and put up their question after the presentation of project and assured the public that their questions will be answered by the Project Proponents. Thereafter he asked the Project Proponent to give presentation of project.

Environmental Consultant (for project proponent) Dr. Dharna Tiwari (EIA coordinator) presented the case and explained about the "Integrated Solid Waste Management Project" at Malpura and Rajpura village, Tehsil Dharuhera, District Rewari, Haryana as detailed below:

Municipal Committee the "Authority" intends for "Integrated Solid Waste Management" Project at Malpura and Rajpura village, Tehsil Dharuhera, District Rewari, Haryana. The project is aligned with the Master Plan projections and conforms to the latest **Solid Waste Management Rules 2016**. Dharuhera, with a population of 30,344 in 2011 and a projected increase to 49,000 by 2031, generates 15.2 tons of waste per day, anticipated to rise to 24.5 TPD over the next 20 years. The main solid waste generation sources are residential, commercial, food markets, religious place and street sweeping.



After the completion of Presentation by project proponent, the general public raised their Queries/ suggestion which are given as below:

What steps are being taken to address this delay?	Project proponent explained that the proposed project is intended to improve the current situation by ensuring scientific disposal of waste, preventing illegal dumping through strict enforcement and challans, and developing a green belt to enhance the aesthetics of the area. With these measures in place, the site can be restored and repurposed to support community needs such as maintaining a children's stadium or developing a school making the place safe, healthy, and beneficial for the public once again. SDM, Rewari has also informed that the proposed project will process the dumped waste present at dumping site.
2	Sh. Madan Lal	Dharuhera	We have a serious concern regarding the setting up of this plant. There's a sports stadium nearby, but due to presence of existing dumping yard no one is able to play. I have raised complaints regarding this issue several times, but no action has been taken.	Project proponent explained that the proposed project is intended to improve the current situation by ensuring scientific disposal of waste, preventing illegal dumping through strict enforcement and challans, and developing a green belt to enhance the

			Daily dumping of waste at this location is creating severe problems, and as a result, children have completely stopped coming here to play.	aesthetics of the area. While the paperwork and statutory approvals for the new integrated facility to manage fresh waste may still take a few months, we assure the public that, in the meantime, immediate steps will be taken to address the problems arising from the existing dumping yard. With these measures in place, the site can be restored and repurposed to support community needs such as developing a children's stadium or a school making the place safe, healthy, and beneficial for the public once again.

Himmat Singh	Village Jandali Khatani	The public expressed concern that the continuous dumping of waste has resulted in a strong foul odor, causing serious inconvenience and health issues for the nearby residents	Project proponent explained the methods to address issues such as foul odour and improve environmental conditions, the following mitigation measures will be adopted: 1. Use of bio-filters and deodorizing agents to neutralize smells. 2. Fencing and green buffer zones with tree plantations around the site. 3. Strict environmental monitoring of air, water, and soil. 4. For preventing foul smell, Herbal sanitizer will be used at site. This initiative is a step toward ensuring scientific waste processing , rather than dumping thereby minimizing any adverse impact on nearby areas.

	Kumar, Sarpanch representative		clarification where will this new waste management facility be set up.	clarified that the proposed Integrated Waste Management Facility will be established on the same site where the public hearing is being conducted. The project is planned on a total area of 3.7 acre of land adjacent to the existing dumping yard, and this new site will be dedicated exclusively for the scientific management of fresh waste generated in the area.
5	Sh. Dharam Singh	Rajpura	The public asked that the location of the proposed plant be changed, expressing their objection to setting up the facility at the current site.	The project proponent has explained that the site has been allotted to the Municipal Committee, Dharuhera, and was selected after a thorough technical assessment. It is in full compliance with the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016, as well as other applicable environmental regulations. The proposed project is not meant for indiscriminate dumping, but for the scientific management of fresh waste, with the objective of environmental restoration and safeguarding public health. The proposed site for waste management complies with the site selection criteria outlined in the SWM Rules, 2016, ensuring all necessary

Bhagwan das	Garibnagar, Dharuhera	The public pointed out that the plots near this site were developed in 2019, but there are still no pucca roads in the area	In response, it was clarified that the concern regarding the absence of pucca roads will be addressed. The SDM advised the public to submit a formal application so that the matter can be taken up with the appropriate authorities and necessary action can be ensured.
7	Smt. Kavita	Garibnagar, Dharuhera	The public said that instead of setting up this solid waste facility, a government school be constructed at the site, as there is no school in the vicinity. They highlighted that children currently have to walk 4-5 km to attend school. They further stated that the dumping ground is only creating problems for them, whereas a school would truly benefit the community. The public also sought clarification regarding the timelines for implementation of the proposed project.	The project proponent clarified that once the waste is scientifically processed and managed, the site can be suitably restored and utilized for community needs. With the total available land of 3.7 acres, there will also be scope for developing additional facilities such as a school in the future, as per public requirements. Regarding the project schedule, it is informed that implementation will take approximately 6-7 months. To address current concerns, several environmental measures will be adopted, including regular covering and compaction of waste to control odor, installation of odor-control systems such as bio-filters and natural sprays, proper drainage arrangements to prevent leachate accumulation, and development of 33 %

				green belt within the site to act as a buffer and improve air quality. These measures will effectively control smell, dust, and other related issues, ensuring public health protection and overall environmental improvement.
8	Smt. Vidhya Devi	Garibnagar, Dharuhera	The public pointed out that although a colony has been developed around the dumping yard, there are still no basic amenities provided in the area.	Project proponent assured that the requirements of the surrounding colony will be looked after. The Municipal Committee, Dharuhera , will also take care of such needs under their Corporate Environmental Responsibility (CER) activities. Through these initiatives, efforts will be made to gradually improve the availability of basic amenities in the area, alongside the environmental improvements from the proposed project.
